Joel Baines received his bachelor's degree from Kansas State University in 1979 in Microbiology, followed by his professional veterinary degree at the University of Pennsylvania in 1983 (VMD), and a PhD in Virology at Cornell University in 1988. His formative years were spent in training at the University of Chicago in the laboratory of Bernard Roizman after which he took a position at Cornell University in 1993. He moved up the ranks at that institution and is now the James Law Professor of Virology at the New York State College of Veterinary Medicine at Cornell. He has authored approximately 70 papers and reviews, mostly concerning herpes simplex virus assembly and egress.
