Neal DeLuca received a B.S degree from Lehigh University in 1977. He did his graduate studies at the Pennsylvania State University, where he received M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in Biophysics in 1979 and 1981, respectively. Dr. DeLuca did his postdoctoral research at the Dana Farber Cancer Institute under the mentorship of Dr. Priscilla Schaffer from 1982-1986. In 1986 he was appointed Assistant Professor at the Dana Farber Cancer Institute and Harvard Medical School in the Department of Microbiology and Molecular Genetics. In 1991 he moved the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine, where he is currently Professor of Microbiology and Molecular Genetics.
