We look forward to seeing you on the University of Utah campus in Salt Lake City for the 35th Annual International Herpesvirus Workshop. The following information will help you prepare for your trip and know what to expect while in Salt Lake City.

WEATHER

In July, the average temperature is a high of 91° F (33° C) and a low of 63° F (17° C).

TIME ZONE

Salt Lake City, Utah is currently on Mountain Daylight Time (MDT). MDT is UTC/GMT – 6 hours.

WHAT TO PACK

July is the warmest month in Salt Lake City. Although the days are hot, the valley becomes cool once the sun sets around 21:00. A water bottle will be provided by the Workshop. If you are sun sensitive, please bring sunscreen, a hat and sunglasses. A light sweater is also recommended for the outdoor evenings and the air conditioned sessions. The University of Utah is a walking campus. **DO NOT FORGET YOUR WALKING SHOES.**

PIONEER DAY, SATURDAY, JULY 24

Please be advised that Saturday, July 24 is Pioneer Day. Pioneer Day is a state holiday in Utah and is celebrated each year to commemorate the arrival of Brigham Young and the first group of Mormon pioneers into Utah's Salt Lake Valley in 1847. County offices (except emergency services), educational institutions, and many businesses are closed. Due to the Holiday, buses will run on a Sunday schedule.

Hotel Parking
